



(Enhanced Landscape Maintenance/Lot Levy)



Citadel collects a special tax of \$66.95 annually. This tax is collected from all households in Citadel, West Citadel, and Morningside, and is used to enhance our community outside of what the City of Calgary is able to do. This tax is collected through our city tax program annually.


