## **Accidental Poisoning**

by Alberta Health Services

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) would like to remind parents and caregivers of precautions to prevent accidental childhood poisonings around the home. Ingesting prescription or over the counter (OTC) medications is a significant cause of accidental childhood poisonings. Other causes of poisoning include ingesting or coming into contact with household items such as dishwasher tablets, mouthwash, or chemicals such as paints, solvents and cleaning products.

#### **Medication Storage**

- Place all medications in locked containers and store in an area inaccessible to children
- · For easy identification, store all medications in their original packaging; do not mix multiple medications in a single bottle
- · Install child locks on all cabinets, or drawers where medications are stored

#### **Safety Tips**

- Child-resistant medication bottles are not child proof. They can still be opened by a child
- Take extra precaution with medicines designed to appeal to children such as chewable vitamins or flavored cough and cold syrups
- · Promptly dispose of any medications or toxic household products no longer in use

#### Prevention

- · Store household products, cleaning supplies, and cosmetics in locked cabinets or drawers
- Install child latches on cabinets children might also access by climbing on counters or chairs
- Label all plants in and around your home and garden
- Antifreeze, windshield washer fluid, and pesticides are extremely poisonous. Even small amounts of these can cause serious illness if ingested

Poisoning information can be obtained by calling the Poison and Drug Information Service (PADIS) at: 1-800-332-1414.

In case of a poisoning emergency, call 9-1-1. Provide the name of the product ingested and, if it is safe to do so, a sample of the substance for EMS to inspect on their arrival.



## **Cigarette Litter**

from the City of Calgary



Did you know that cigarette litter is a major environmental concern and contributes to a disproportionate amount of litter in our city? Contrary to popular belief, those white sponge-like butts are not made from cotton or paper instead, they're a synthetic microfibre that takes years to break down and are unsightly around our city.

- · Cigarette filters are one of the most littered items in the world.
- Chemicals that can leach out of cigarette butts include arsenic, ammonia, and lead. The chemicals found in one cigarette butt can leach out and contaminate approximately 7.5 litres of water within one hour. This contaminated water is lethal to aquatic life.
- · Sunlight will degrade a cigarette filter and break it into very small particles. These small pieces do not disappear or biodegrade but wind up in the soil or swept in water, contributing to water pollution.
- The fines for the improper disposal of cigarette litter range from \$250 to \$500, with a maximum fine of \$750 for throwing a butt out of a car window.

If you're a smoker, consider buying a pocket ashtray available locally and from popular online retailers.

### **Deerfoot Trail Improvements**



The Deerfoot Trail Improvements Project launched in early 2023. The project scope currently includes redesign of Glenmore Trail interchange, Southland Drive interchange, Anderson Road interchange, and Ivor Strong Bridge upgrades.

As we are very excited about the anticipated benefits that the Deerfoot Improvements Project will bring to all drivers utilizing this major freeway, we are also very concerned about the prospect of further increased traffic on 18 Street as drivers will want to by-pass the construction on Deerfoot Trail and the safety of pedestrians and cyclists using this street.

In May 2023, Riverbend Community Association sent a letter to MLA Tanya Fir, Office of the

Minister of Transportation and Ward 11 Councilor Kourtney Penner to flag our community's concerns and advocate for preventative measures to be put in place.

We will continue to advocate to engage with the officials and with our community residents to determine long term solutions that will:

- Keep 18 Street safe for pedestrians and cyclist
- Reduce cut-through traffic volumes through our community
- Optimize traffic flow to ensure that our community residents can get in and out of our community safely
