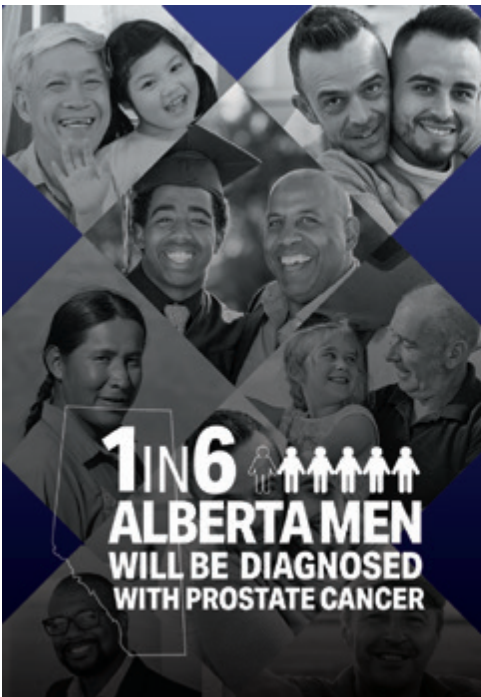

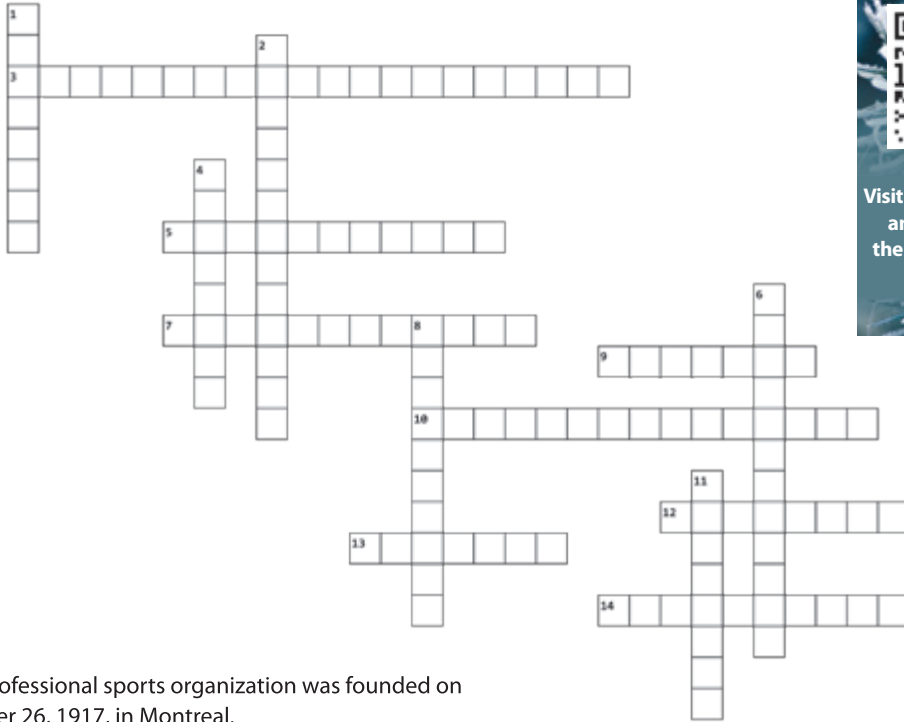

First, I checked the forecast. I wanted some extremely hot weather so that we could take advantage of the hotel's outdoor pool. Then, I made a list of all the sights I wanted us to see.

My hubby had no details; each day for a week leading up to our departure I presented him with a written clue on our adventure. This helped to build excitement and anticipation for our trip. He asked lots of questions, trying hard to guess what we'd be doing. I provided minimal answers, so as not to reveal too much.

I booked our stay at the Hotel Arts in the heart of downtown Calgary. This is a lovely hotel with lots of amenities. We checked in on day one and spent the first afternoon at the outdoor pool, enjoying the sunshine and the snacks and cocktails from the poolside bar.

On day two we began our outdoor adventure. The hotel provides complimentary 7-speed touring bicycles, so we hopped on at 9:00 am and headed out for the day. First stop, the Peace Bridge. First opened in 2012, the cycling/pedestrian bridge is a truly impressive architectural design both from a distance and close. We rode across to Memorial Drive, over to Prince's Island, back to downtown and on to St. Patrick's Island. Of course, we had to stop at Spolumbo's for brunch – wonderful!



The river pathway system is amazing and our day weather-wise could not have been more perfect for cycling. Also, with the school season just starting, we had no crowds to contend with.

After returning our bikes to the hotel, we continued our adventure with the Devonian Gardens, an urban oasis in the heart of the city. After that, it was on to High Park, a rooftop public park and play space on top of the City Centre Parkade.

On day three, our final day, we checked out of our hotel in the morning, leaving our car while we continued to explore the city on foot. Our next stops were the Central Library and Studio Bell, home of the National Music Centre. Neither my husband nor I are familiar with architecture, but the design and beauty of the buildings overwhelmed us both. They are truly beautiful structures.
